COUNCILLOR DUEHAY

- WHEREAS: On the 22nd day of May 1978, death brought to a close the active life of Arthur Drinkwater at the age of 98 years; and
- WHEREAS: Arthur Drinkwater was one of Harvard's oldest alumni, having served as the Secretary of the Class of 1900 and was a leading figure in the Annual Commencement Parade proudly carrying the banner of his class; and
- WHEREAS: Arthur Drinkwater was a vigorous fund raiser for Harvard College and the Law School from which he graduated in 1903 and had an outstanding career at the bar and served as a member of the Cambridge City Council for five years from 1920 after his return from World War I, where he served as a Captain in the 151st Field Artillery Brigade; and
- WHEREAS: Arthur Drinkwater was active in many Boston and Cambridge civic organizations including the Harvard Club of Boston, the Skating Club of Boston, the Cambridge Historical Society and the Family Welfare Society of Boston; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That in the passing of Arthur Drinkwater, the University City and Harvard College lost an outstanding citizen who made lasting contributions to the political life of Cambridge and the Alumni Affairs of Harvard College; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That this resolution be spread upon the minutes of the City Council and a copy thereof be sent to his family in recognition of Arthur Drinkwater's respected place in this community.
