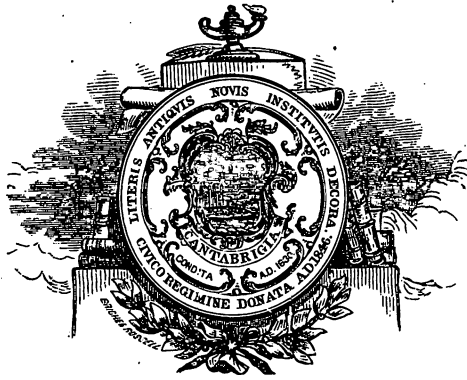

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that

River Street
should be widened on its northerly side
between Central Square and Blackstone Street,
by taking for this purpose certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land on *the northerly side of*
River Street
between Central Square and Blackstone St.,

as is included between the *red* lines shown on a plan of *River Street*
on file in the office of
~~Street, drawn by~~ the City Engineer, dated *August 4, 1873* and now before this
Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said *River*
Street.
