In response to Awaiting Report #39 of May 14, 1990 regarding the intersection of Middlesex and Pemberton Streets, the following is the information:

Chief of Police Anthony Paollilo reports that a one-officer unit from North Cambridge has been assigned to the area Monday through Friday, 3:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. The officer is responsible for enforcing all motor vehicle violations, parking violations and violations of the noise ordinance.

William Sommers, Commissioner of Public Works, reports that the street corner will be repaired within the next month. Additionally, with the approval of the Traffic Department, bollards will be installed on the corner to keep the trucks from jumping the curb and breaking the sidewalk.
