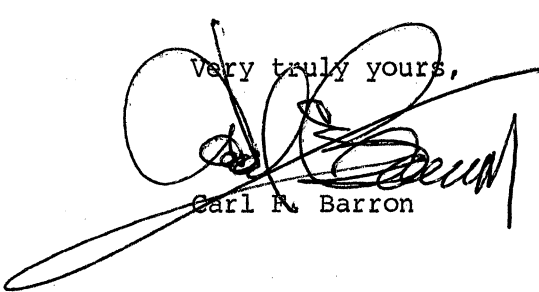
On behalf of my Association, I am requesting a hearing before the City Council on Monday, May 12, 1980, at any time convenient for the City Council.
