To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$879,000.00 in the Public Investment Fund of the Community Development Department Extraordinary Expenditures Account (\$879,000). The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has awarded funds through its HOME Program, a major element of the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, which was established to provide assistance to municipalities for expansion of the supply of decent, safe and affordable housing. \$745,150 will be applied directly to affordable housing development. \$131,850 will go to our local Community Housing Development Organizations (CHDOs), Just-A-Start and Homeowner's Rehab. The expenditure of funds will be administered by the CDD, which will base its selection of projects on the City's Consolidated plan, approved annually by HUD. Said activities may include acquisition, moderate or substantial rehabilitation, or new construction of housing units for very low and low-income families or individuals who require social service support.
