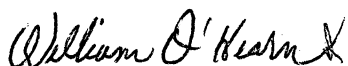
Dear Members of the Cambridge City Council,

This letter has been written pursuant to a unanimous vote of the North Cambridge Stabilization Committee on January 12, 1995.

The North Cambridge Stabilization Committee is deeply concerned that it has not been sufficiently consulted regarding development at the Fitzgerald School. The recent establishment of the Family Center at the School, and the prior citing of the portable classroom at the rear of the building are but two examples of decisions made without prior consultation of the Committee.

The Stabilization Committee is a recognized forum for neighborhood dialogue in North Cambridge. To avoid animosity the School Department and the Department of Human Services should seek the input of our committee before, rather than after, decisions are made about major program initiatives in North Cambridge. We request that representatives from these departments meet with us to improve communication with our committee and to further clarify their goals and objectives in our neighborhood.
