- WHEREAS: This City Council learned with great joy on April 24, 1985 that Archbishop Bernard F. Law has been elected to the College of Cardinals at Vatican ceremonies on May 25, 1985; and
- WHEREAS: Bernard F. Law will become the fourth Boston Archbishop to be named Cardinal, joining an illustrious group of predecessors, which included the late Cardinal William Henry O'Connell who was elected to the College of Cardinals in 1911, Cardinal Richard J. Cushing who was the shepherd of the Archdiocese for twenty-six years and Cardinal Humberto S. Medeiros, who served as Cardinal from 1973 to 1983; and
- WHEREAS: Archbishop Bernard F. Law has dedicated his life to being a bridge builder between people of different faiths, outlooks and races; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record congratulating Cardinal-Designate Bernard F. Law as he assumes his new role in the College of Cardinals with every hope for success, good health and long fruitful years in the vineyard of the Lord; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is directed to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Archbishop Bernard F. Law on behalf of the entire City Council.
