WHEREAS: The hope is that through this television program, parents will become a part of the fire safety education of their children and will reinforce these lessons with them; and

WHEREAS: Along with the program, there will be a contest for all Children in the City of Cambridge to "Name the Smoke Detector Puppet"; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That All children in the City of Cambridge are urged to become members of the Cambridge Fire Department Television Fire Safety Clubhouse and enter the contest, by visiting their nearest Fire House and filling out an entry blank and receive a membership certificate; and further be it
