Subject Traffic Flow Around Hyatt Regency Hotel

The Traffic Department has been meeting with officers of the Hyatt Hotel as well as watching the traffic circulation with a view towards alleviating the existing traffic problems.

We have restricted parking on Amesbury Street to allow for a freer flow of traffic and we will be evaluating this restriction as to whether it has helped the traffic circulation. We are also working with the hotel management on the signing of the area and will take whatever steps needed to assist them.

We have also found that there is some confusion and a lot of sightseers driving around this hotel and that this will be eliminated in time.

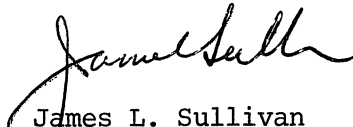
