WHEREAS:

On April 2nd, 1974, after the fire at ~~9~~ to 19 Cambridge Street in Inman Square was extinguished and the "fire out" declared by the Fire Chief, the premises were left exposed and unsecured; and in the early hours of the evening in the absence of adequate surveillance looting occurred; and that this situation occurred because the landlord apparently failed to provide such surveillance; therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That when a fire or explosion occurs, the City of Cambridge be charged with the responsibility of ascertaining whether the occupants of the damaged premises are capable of protecting said premises, and in the event they are not, assume the responsibility for assuring that the premises are adequately secured and protected from vandalism and are kept under surveillance for a minimum period of twenty-four hours after a "fire out" is declared, or until such further time as the occupants are able to resume that responsibility.
