- WHEREAS: These elderly residents are complaining about cars which are parked illegally and oftentimes double-parked in front of the Purity Supreme Market and the Dunkin Donuts Coffee Shop; and
- WHEREAS: These illegally parked cars present a hazard to all citizens, particularly the seniors; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Police Department to enforce the parking requirements and restrictions on Massachusetts Avenue in front of these establishments.
