WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board, the public safety and convenience require that the streets hereinafter mentioned should be laid out as public streets, to wit:

Sodon Street, from Western Avenue to Franklin St;
Kinnaird " " " " " near Bay "
and thence to Putnam Avenue,—

Jay Street, from Western Avenue to Kinnaird St.
Howard " " " " " " "
Bay " " Main Street " " "
Hancock " " " " " Franklin "
Vernon " " " " " Green "
Reed " " Spruce " " Harvey "
Lake " " Pearl " " Magazine "

all forty feet in width except that part of Kinnaird St. from near Bay street to Putnam Avenue, which is to be laid out thirty five feet in width,—and Hancock street, which is to be laid out twenty-six feet in width, It is therefore hereby

ORDERED, That due notice be given to the owners of the land over which it is proposed to lay out said Streets, and all other persons interested, that this Board intends to lay out the Streets before mentioned, by taking a portion of their land and laying out the same as public streets—and that

MONDAY,

the 28th day of December current, at
8 o'clock, P. M.,
is assigned as the time for hearing any objections which may be made thereto.
