

To provide reimbursement as follows:

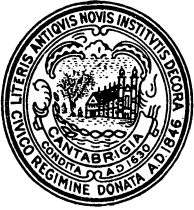
