WHEREAS: At the October 18th meeting at the Agassiz Neighborhood Council, Alan Fein, Vice President for Finance and Administration at Lesley College was asked about Lesley's intent to acquire other properties within the Agassiz neighborhood; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Fein advised the Agassiz Neighborhood Council that Lesley was not seeking to acquire any two and three family homes in Agassiz or any other neighborhoods in Cambridge, however, Mr. Fein stated that in regards to the Sacramento Street property, that if Lesley could convert housing on campus to dorms, then dorm space on Sacramento Street could be sold; and

WHEREAS: It is in the interest of the City to work with Lesley to assist them if possible in this endeavor; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with Mr. Fein of Lesley College to see if the City can assist in this endeavor and to further request Lesley that should they be able to achieve their goal of converting housing on campus to dorms, that the Sacramento Street property be offered to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund of the City as a gift and that the Affordable Housing Trust Fund create limited equity condominiums for people of low and moderate income of Cambridge.
