School sports is focus of Feb. 6 gathering

Parents of Rindge and Latin student/athletes and incoming eighth-graders are invited to participate in a "Cambridge Athletics" community meeting Thursday, Feb. 6, 7-9 pm in the CRLS Main Cafeteria.

The purpose of the meeting is to include parents and community members in a city-wide effort to support the continued development and expansion of after-school sports programs that are an integral part of Cambridge Public Schools' comprehensive Health, Physical Education and Athletics program.

There are two goals for the meeting:

- Create a working group of parents and community members who will explore different ways to raise outside revenue and seek in-kind support for the continued expansion of CRLS athletic activities.

Over the last few years, the school committee has added significant funds to rebuild athletics by reinstituting the elementary after-school athletic/intramural program and by creating gender equity throughout all sports programs. But the schools cannot expect continued increases with the current financial outlook.

- Begin focused conversations between coaches and team parents around the formation of "booster clubs" for each sport. The purpose of these booster clubs will be to increase parent involvement, as well as to channel resources toward the specific needs of individual teams, such as end-of-season banquets, player awards, team T-shirts, practice uniforms, extra equipment and special trips.
