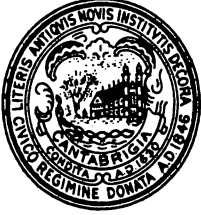


To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached appropriation transfer, in the amount of \$7,500.00, is prompted by a request presented to the City Manager by the Cambridge Chamber of Commerce. In a letter dated March 30, 1976, Joseph Fantasia, Chairman of the Cambridge Tourist and Convention Bureau, requested a City investment of \$7,500.00 in the Tourist and Convention Bureau, a newly-formed branch of the Cambridge Chamber of Commerce. In his letter, Mr. Fantasia stated, "Our goal is to further develop Cambridge as a market for visitors, thus increasing the business climate and, in the long run, jobs and tax base expansion".

We agree that this promotion will have direct benefits to the City and its residents and can be a meaningful economic development effort. Therefore, with City Council approval, we will make this investment, in the amount of \$7,500.00, to be matched with private funds from the Bureau.
