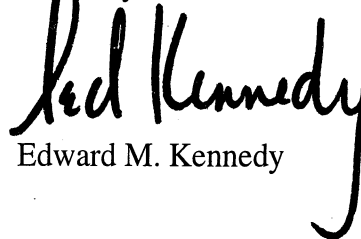
Thank you for your correspondence regarding Ms. Bela Bhasin's appeal for a green card.
