- WHEREAS: At this gala luncheon, the YWCA will celebrate the achievements of ten outstanding women; and
- WHEREAS: Ulrike Welsch, noted photographer, will receive a 2004 YWCA Outstanding Woman Award; and
- WHEREAS: Karen Holmes, Director of Public Affairs and Community Services and "City Line" Executive Producer, will receive a 2004 YWCA Outstanding Woman Award; and
- WHEREAS: Karen has worked with Channel 5 since 1981; she now oversees all WCVB-TV public service and community outreach, including the weekly magazine-type program that addresses the accomplishments and concerns of people of color living in the greater Boston area. As *City Line* host, she has interviewed notables from Oprah Winfrey and Denzel Washington to Louis Farrakhan. She has produced any number of Emmy-nominated specials; and
- WHEREAS: Karen donates time to non-profit organizations such as Habitat for Humanity. She is also a board member of Historic Neighborhoods Foundation and City Year, past president of Roxbury Comprehensive Community Health Center, and founder of the Coalition of 100 Black Women, Boston chapter; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record congratulating Karen Holmes on being recognized by the Cambridge YWCA as a 2004 Outstanding Woman; and be it further
