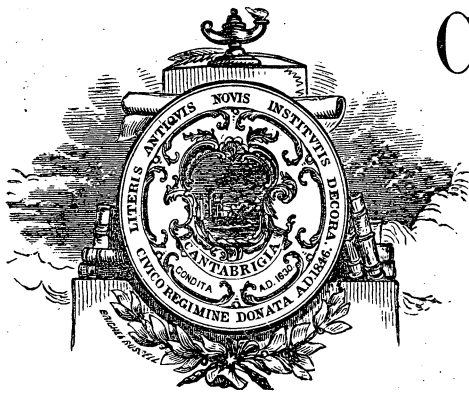




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Dec 13 1871.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Pearl Street from a point about One hundred feet northerly of Coie Street to a Twentyfive foot-passage-way at its southerly terminus

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land Forty feet in width between

the ~~same~~ above mentioned points and

included between the red lines as shown on a plan drawn by J. G. Chase City Engineer dated Sept-27th 1871

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that no damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid.

Ordered, That thirty days be allowed to the persons whose land is taken for said Street, for the removal of their fences standing on the land so taken as aforesaid,

A copy to be sent to the persons concerned.
