At no time have I ever been brutal, discourteous or in any other manner treated blacks as so stated in the order approved by the members of the Cambridge City Council on June 10, 1974.

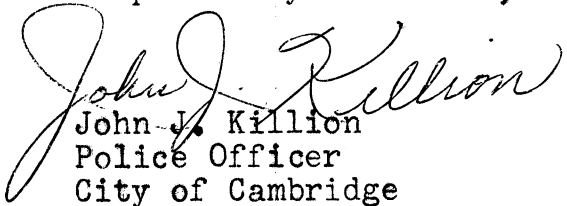

If not, I have no other recourse but to seek legal justification against Councilor Graham and the members of the City Council that approved this order.

It seems to me that THE INCOMPETENT ARE LEADING THE UNWILLING TO DO THE IMPOSSIBLE FOR THE UNGRATEFUL.
