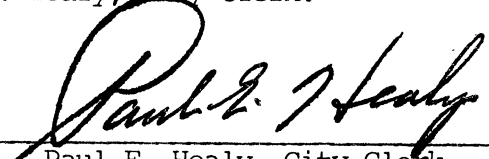
MAYOR RUSSELL

- WHEREAS: This City Council wishes to recognize and commend exemplary performance by members of the Cambridge Police Department; and
- WHEREAS: During the early morning hours of May 1, 1984 Officer Joseph Frawley, while patrolling on Huron Avenue, followed an automobile that matched the description of one reported only minutes earlier as having taken part in armed robbery; and
- WHEREAS: After reporting his observance of the suspect vehicle, Officer Frawley, with great risk to his personal safety, pursued the suspect's vehicle and managed to bring it to a stop; and
- WHEREAS: A subsequent search of the suspect vehicle produced two handguns and an amount of stolen property that helped to solve the robbery of that morning and several previous unsolved robberies; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council do hereby officially congratulate and commend Patrol Officer Joseph Frawley for his quick response and courageous actions on the morning of May 1, 1984 in assisting in the pursuit and arrest of armed robbery suspects; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That a copy of this City Council resolution be made a part of his permanent record.
