WHEREAS: The Cambridge Rescue Wagon has been "out of service" recently; and

WHEREAS: The #2 "backup" van is not allowed to transport emergency victims to the hospital thus causing Cambridge citizens (usually elderly) to pay for a private ambulance service which they cannot afford; therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to see that the Cambridge Rescue Wagon is immediately made operable and available and that the #2 "backup" van is made eligible for transporting emergency victims; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager is requested to report back one week from this date on this matter.
