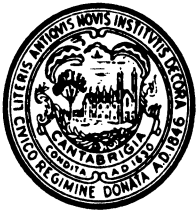

As per the memo of October 15, 1990, with regard to the above-listed property, please be advised that Mr. LaVash of Public Works Department notified the owner, Mr. Bernard for a Board of Survey in or about October 16, 1990. The owner stated that the building was in the process of being sold, and he could not grant permission for Inspectional Services Department to enter the premises.
