WHEREAS: Armand was a member of 256th Infantry Brigade, Louisiana Army National Guard; and

WHEREAS: Armand's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family; and

WHEREAS: Armand will be sorely missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Specialist Armand Frickey at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
