We respectfully request a hearing before the City Council to inform the Council on the irregularities connected with M.I.T.'s March 15th demolition of three rent controlled houses on Blanche Street. We believe that it would be helpful for the Director of the Rent Control Board, the Commissioner of Inspectional Services, and the City Manager to be present at this hearing.

These houses, plus two other occupied homes, have been the subject of litigation since 1985. The City Council voted in January to ask M.I.T. to delay demolition until after the tenants had exercised their appeal rights. M.I.T. didn't wait. We hope that some light would be shed on why city departments cooperated in this expedited demolition and who ordered them to do so. Thank you for your consideration.
