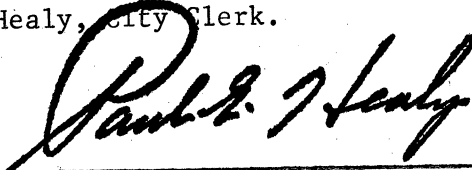
COUNCILLOR WALTER SULLIVAN

- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record requesting the City Manager to take the appropriate steps to replace the signs at the entrance to the hospital to read "The Cambridge City Hospital"; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That a new sign be erected at the corner of Cambridge Street and Camelia Avenue which is properly illuminated, said sign to read "Cambridge City Hospital-Emergency Entrance".

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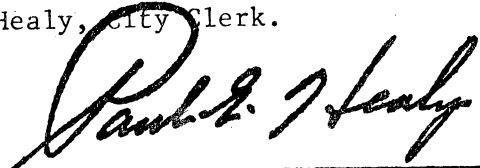
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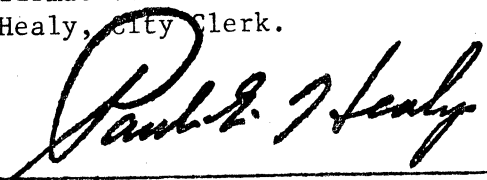
