To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to your request for information regarding accidental disability pension, please be advised that upon approval by the Retirement Board of an accidental disability pension, an individual is entitled to 72% of his base pay retroactive to his last date on the payroll.

Upon the individual's death his widow would be eligible to file for an annuity.

If special legislation were filed to increase the accidental disability from 72% to 100%, the widow would be entitled to only that which was specified in the legislation, e. g. two-thirds (2/3) of a regular pension.
