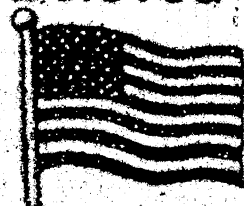

Petition to Neil L. Rudenstine, President, Harvard University

We the undersigned oppose the proposed construction of the Knafel Center on the Sumner/Kirkland/Cambridge/Quincy street block. A 75,000 square foot building for six hundred people cannot but violate our residential neighborhood. It will degrade the quality of our lives with excessive traffic, parking, pollution, noise, wind, shadow and loss of beauty, vista, green space, history and character.

Further, we oppose construction which would:

Require relief from zoning, evictions or loss of rental units.

Demolish, significantly alter, remove or relocate historical, landmark or wood frame structures on the site.

Structurally damage or enshadow the Swedenborg Chapel.

We request that Harvard University respect the letter and spirit of its own stated Planning Principles to preserve open space, promote a human scale, reinforce the historical character of the University, minimize vehicular activity and treat University edges with attention to the concerns of neighbors.

We insist that Harvard abandon its current site plans for Knafel Center.
