In Board of Aldermen, September 20th 1871

Whereas;

It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that Channing Street so called from Brattle Street to Mount Auburn Street be laid out as a public way,

Ordered,

That said Channing Street be and hereby is laid out and established as a public way, by the name of Channing Street agreeably to a plan and profile thereof drawn by the City Engineer, bearing date of August 26th 1871 and now before this Board, to wit from Brattle Street to Mount Auburn Street, the same to be fifty feet in width as shown by the red lines delineated on said plan. Ordered, That no damages be awarded to the persons over whose land said Channing Street is laid out as aforesaid,
