In City Council,

May 7, 1973

WHEREAS:

The present session of The Great Court of Massachusetts is considering House Bill No. 3195, Equalized Assessment of State and County Taxes, and

WHEREAS:

This Bill will stop the inequitable taxation for county expenditures on an antiquated formula and will instead cause county taxes to be apportioned by the equalized valuation of each town in the county and

WHEREAS:

This Bill will reduce the county tax for Cambridge by approximately one million dollars, which it presently pays due to an inequitable formula,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

That the City Council of the City of Cambridge hereby supports this Bill and urges its passage, and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

That the City Manager of the City of Cambridge contact other towns who also stand to benefit from this Bill, contact legislators on the City's behalf, and to take all such actions which are necessary or expedient to promote the passage of this Bill.
