WHEREAS: Besides its course work, career and college preparation, and the feeling of family camaraderie, the Leadership Program has a required community service program for its students to learn practical civics and to give back to the community where they live; and

WHEREAS: The Leadership School, in its short existence, has made an impression on the local community, which it serves, and the Thomas Jefferson Forum, the community service component of Leadership, now has twenty members contributing to the improvement of life within Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: The service and dedication of these students will be honored at a luncheon at the Cantabrigia Restaurant, Cambridge Rindge and Latin School, on February 14, 1991; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to be presented to Dr. Paula Tucker-Hogan of the Leadership School for the entire program.
