WHEREAS: December 10, 1986 is the 38th anniversary of the United Nations' Universal Declaration of Human Rights which spells out the fundamental rights to which all persons are entitled; and

WHEREAS: December 10, 1986 is International Human Rights Day; and

WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge has a strong tradition of support for the preservation of human rights on the local, national and international levels; and

WHEREAS: Presently, the City of Cambridge continues this tradition by opposing discrimination, whatever be its source; and

WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge has established the Cambridge Human Rights Commission and other city agencies for the purpose of preserving the human rights of all; and

WHEREAS: The protection and promotion of human rights compels the commitment and concern of each citizen within the scope of his/her influence; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council declares December 10, 1986 as HUMAN RIGHTS DAY in Cambridge and encourages all residents in Cambridge to note this special day, to share in its observance, and, on every day, work to promote the protection of human rights; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a duly engrossed copy of this Resolution and forward same to Ms. Sarah Wunsch, Executive Director of the Cambridge Human Rights Commission.
