To the Honorable the City Council

of the City of Cambridge,

Gentlemen:-

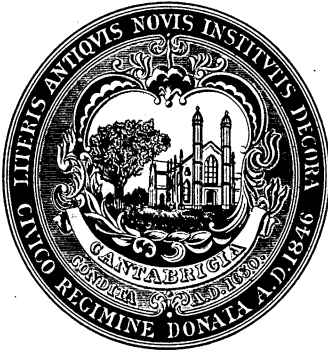
In 1904 at a cost of over two thousand dollars (\$2,000.) a portion of the foundation wall of the Brattle Square Building was repaired.

Now it appears that at this same point the building gives every evidence from a close examination, to be in a dangerous condition, the constantly moving fire apparatus increasing this danger. To meet this situation there are two plans of action open:-first, to repair the unsafe portion of the building which will cost approximately three thousand dollars (\$3,000.), or second, now that it is definitely settled that the Third District Court of Eastern Middlesex will vacate its quarters in August and the Electrical Department will be ready to move next January, for the city to plan for the sale of the Brattle Square Building and provide new quarters for the police and fire departments in some other location.

It is essential that some definite action be taken on this matter at the earliest possible moment.

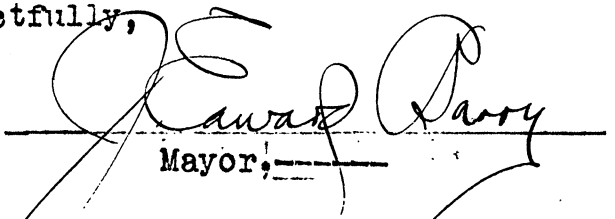

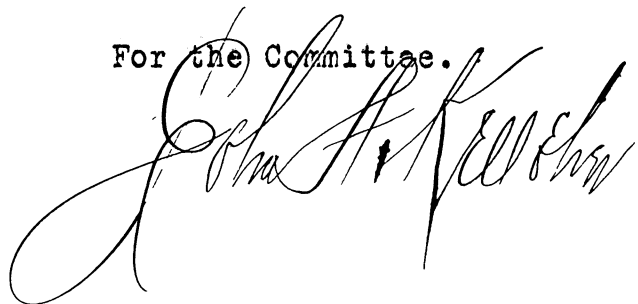
ON PUBLIC PROPERTY
