That the Committee on Roads and Bridges be authorized to advertise for proposals and to contract for 60,000 Paving Blocks for the purpose of completing the paving of Main Street, as far as Pelham Street, being the work begun in the year 1884 and not finished,

also

To advertise for proposals and contracts for 1000 running feet of Edge-stones, more or less.

The expense of the foregoing to be charged to the appropriation for Street Department, (Paving.)
