The undersigned respectfully pray

I am petitioning for a curb cut because I feel I am being harassed. I have lived at 71 Tremont St. for 2 months. During this time, my car has been vandalized on 5 different occasions. First, I lost a calculator and C.B. radio when someone broke into my car; I was away from the car for only 15 minutes. The second time, my antenna was stolen. In the third incident, a tire was slashed. The fourth time, air was let out of a tire. Fifth, and most recent, my antenna bracket, which was attached by 4 bolts, was taken.

I have a light outside my door which remains on all night. It clearly illuminates the area in front of my home, but it evidently is not much of a deterrent. I am asking for this curb cut so that I can protect my own property by placing my automobile in the yard behind a locked fence. There are groups of kids that hang around the corner of my street, and I have had difficulty keeping them off my car. I cannot prove that they are responsible for the damage, but the problem is becoming more serious.

Mr. Dottin was denied a curb cut at the above address, because of the following: there is only eight feet in width from abutters fence to his house, and approximately ten feet between the two houses, both of which are built of wood.

In addition, there is a sidewalk catch basin in the curb cut area and partially on the abutters sidewalk. This condition would entail reconstruction of the catch basin to convert to a manhole in sidewalk, and a new street catch basin, frame and cover would have to be installed at the expense of the owner of the driveway.

If the Traffic Department and Building Department approve of the non-conforming driveway, and the owner will pay all expenses involved, the Public Works Department will proceed with above work, weather permitting. Thank you .
