LUIZ VAZ CAMOES

Camões or Camoëns, Luiz Vas DeCamões (1524-80) Portuguese lyric and epic poet, born at Lisbon. He was educated at the University of Coimbra, where he acquired an extensive knowledge of Latin and Greek literature. He led an adventurous life (the inspiration for many of his poems). He was a friend in the Royal Court in Lisbon, two years' of service in the Portuguese army in North Africa (1547-49), during which he lost an eye; and army service and civil service post in India (1553-69). He was the author of numerous sonnets, eclogues, elegies, odes, satires, epigrams and canzonis; a number of plays, including *Os Amphytriones* and *Filodemo*; and the the Portuguese National epic, *Os Lusidas* (published in 1572), generally known in English as the *Lusiads*. Camoes brought the Portuguese lyric to its highest point of perfection, and his epic is considered one of the greatest written in Europe during Renaissance times.

The City Council demands that the Commonwealth immediately convene the citizens advisory panel on Scheme Z called for by the Secretary of Environmental Affairs, and that no decision on any final EIS/R be made until such a panel has completed its work.
