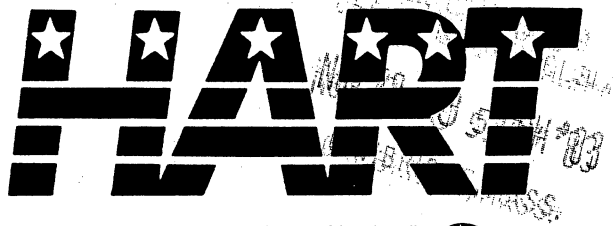

Dear Friend,

In a major Boston appearance, Congressman Morris Udall will join Presidential candidate Gary Hart to discuss "Environmental Issues in the 1980's" on the evening of November 30, 1983. The Seventies were years of legislative progress for the Environmental movement. However, the Eighties have presented new and more complex environmental problems which remain unaddressed by the Reagan Administration, including toxic wastes and acid rain.

Both Congressman Udall and Senator Hart have been leaders in the legislative fight for environmental quality. For example, Mo Udall pushed the Alaskan Lands Bill through Congress, a feat the Almanac of American Politics called the "foremost achievement of the environmental movement in the Congress in the late 1970's." Indeed, Audobon Magazine recently hailed Congressman Udall as "a national treasure."

Gary Hart has an outstanding record on environmental issues. He is a member of the Senate's Committee on Environment and Public Works, and has co-sponsored legislation to reduce by 50% the emissions which cause acid rain. Senator Hart has taken the lead on other environmental issues as well, having proposed legislation to expand the toxic waste cleanup "Superfund" program ten-fold and introduced the Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1983.

The League of Conservation Voters has said of Senator Hart:

"Of all the Presidential contenders, Senator Gary Hart is probably the most publicly identified as an environmentalist, and with good reason. He has been active on more issues and has done more to influence environmental legislation than any of the others."

Please come to the Cabot Room at 3 Joy Street (off Beacon St., near Park Street Station) on November 30th between 5 and 6:30 P.M. and hear Mo Udall and Gary Hart air their views on the status and prospects of pressing environmental issues.
