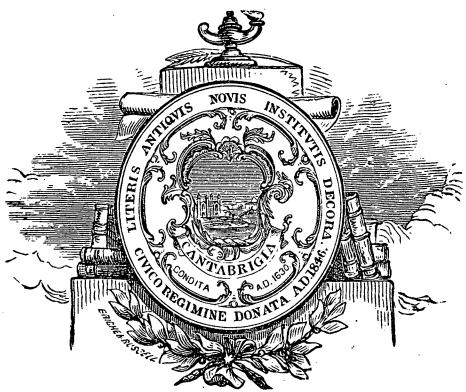




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

the sole owner of said land having waived the usual notice of such taking, and released the same to the city,
