ORDERED: That the following transfer be made from the Grant Fund of the City of Cambridge:

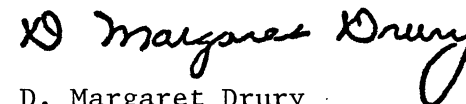

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$136,540.87 from the Grant Fund Community Development Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to the Grant Fund Community Development Salary & Wages Account to provide funds for the salary and benefits for the Data Administrator (\$65,320) who will work with the City's MIS Department to develop the database needed to meet the requirements of the Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Program.

In addition, in order for indirect costs related to the use of fiscal and administrative staff to be properly charged in the City's financial system, it is necessary for the eligible funds to be included in the Salary & Wages Account (\$71,220.87).
