- WHEREAS: Captain Gallagher was appointed to the department in 1953 having served his country well during World War II, as a member of the United States Navy; and
- WHEREAS: Throughout his career Henry Gallagher always strove toward excellence and professionalism keeping current on appropriate laws and municipal ordinances and studying intently for promotional exams, successfully competing in several such tests; being promoted to the rank of Sergeant on January 2, 1966, Lieutenant in August of 1969 and to the rank of Captain in January of 1983; and
- WHEREAS: Captain Gallagher, having served as Commander of the Internal Affairs Bureau and the Criminal Investigation Division, has twice been chosen by the City Manager to serve the department as Acting Chief of Police, the position from which he will retire on Thursday, January 31, 1991; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation to Acting Chief of Police Henry P. Gallagher for his dedication to law enforcement and to the people of Cambridge as he completes thirty-eight years of service; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Chief Gallagher on behalf of the entire City Council with its strong desire that he and his wife enjoy their retirement with much good health and happiness.
