- WHEREAS: The greater Boston area continues to be the center of Lupus research, awareness and assistance; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record declaring the period October 20-26, 1985 as "Lupus Awareness Week" and urge the citizens of Cambridge to recognize this important and vital observance.
