- WHEREAS: Katherine was active in her community, both civically and religiously and was a person to whom her many friends and colleagues went for advice and guidance; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the entire Tobin family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
