IN CITY COUNCIL

May 1, 1917.

Ordered,

That the sum of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000) be and the same hereby is appropriated for the purpose of constructing a Municipal Building on the site of the present Central Square City Building (so-called). Said sum to include the cost of original equipment and furnishing.

Said building to be planned for the accommodation of such municipal and departmental purposes as the City Council may designate.

and it is further

Ordered

That a City Debt be Created

for the sum of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000)

for the purpose of constructing a Municipal Building in Central Square on the site of the present Central Square City Building (so-called) as authorized by Chapter 719, Section 5 (4) Acts of 1913,

and from time to time as the City Treasurer may deem necessary bonds of the City will be issued not exceeding that amount, either in the form of registered or coupon bonds, one or both, to be styled

BUILDING LOAN

said bonds to be dated July 1, 1917 payable \$4000 each year 1918 to 1937

both included

with interest at the rate of not exceeding $4\frac{1}{2}$ per centum per annum, payable semi-annually; that the Mayor, City Auditor and City Treasurer be and are hereby authorized and instructed to sign and execute said bonds and all transfers and exchanges of the same in the manner directed by the ordinances of the City, and that the City Treasurer be and is hereby directed to bargain and sell, and is hereby authorized to transfer and exchange the same.

In City Council

October 16, 1917.

WHEREAS:- The City Council at its meeting of June 12, 1917 appropriated \$ 80,000.00 for the construction of a new building on the site of the present Central Square Building, for the accommodation of such municipal and departmental purposes as the City Council may designate; and

WHEREAS:- At the present time there is being prepared under the orders of His Honor, the Mayor, or the Superintendent of Public Buildings - a set of plans for a building the cost of which would be greatly in excess of the amount so appropriated, and

WHEREAS:- The City Council has not as yet designated what municipal and departmental purposes said building shall be planned to accommodate as is required by the original appropriation order:-

IT IS THEREFORE:

ORDERED:- That the Committee on Public Property and Institutions be and hereby is requested to confer with His Honor, the Mayor, and Superintendent of Buildings as to the purposes the building shall be planned to accommodate and to report at the earliest possible date.
