- WHEREAS: Firefighter Joyce was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant on March 15, 1967 and assigned to Engine Three where he remained until January 3, 1971 at which time he was assigned as Civil Defense Training Officer where he remained until December 15, 1976 when he was transferred to Engine One, the assignment from which he retired; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation and gratitude to Lieutenant William E. Joyce upon his retirement and to further extend its wishes for a healthy and happy retirement; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Lieutenant Joyce on behalf of the entire City Council.
