To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached please find for your review and action an order requesting the acceptance and appropriation of a grant in the amount of \$71,000.00 from the Massachusetts Department of Welfare to the Department of Human Service Programs Grant Fund. This requested appropriation will be allocated as follows: Salaries and Wages, \$53,470.00; Other Ordinary Maintenance, \$17,330.00; and Travel and Training, \$200.00.

For the third consecutive year, the Community Learning Center will provide literacy and other basic skills instruction to AFDC and General Relief recipients who are registered in the employment and training program and who read at or below a sixth grade level. Program participants may then go on to enter a skills training program, further education, or meaningful employment.

Passage of this order is recommended.
