COUNCILLOR CYR

- WHEREAS: Cambridge residents have grown to expect a high level of participation in all of the Regulatory Boards and Commissions within the City; and
- WHEREAS: There is no comprehensive set of rules or procedures for these various boards, including which board is responsible for what areas and activities; and
- WHEREAS: Questions remain about the current distribution of responsibilities and functions; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to organize a Task Force of appropriate agency staff and board participants to review the structure and procedures of Cambridge regulatory boards with the goal of harmonizing their procedures and rationalizing the distribution of their workload; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Task Force be prepared to meet with the Community Development and Housing Subcommittee by January 15, 1991 to discuss an outline and timeline.
