- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Nishan Semonian on November 3, 1982 after a brief illness at the age of ninety-six years; and
- WHEREAS: Nishan Semonian came to the United States from Harpoot, Armenia in the year 1904, settling in Woburn, Massachusetts and worked in a shoe factory in order to bring his family to this country and in 1930 along with his late brother, Charles founded the Fresh Pond Market here in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Nishan Semonian was a charter member of the building committee for the Holy Trinity Armenian Church located on Brattle Street and considered his efforts in the creation of this beautiful edifice as his greatest contribution to the community; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deep sympathy to Mrs. Aznive Semonian and the entire Semonian family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Semonian on behalf of the entire City Council.

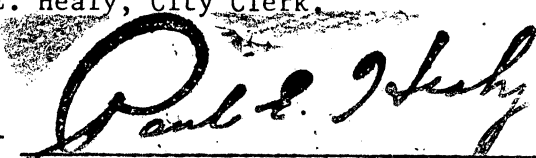
