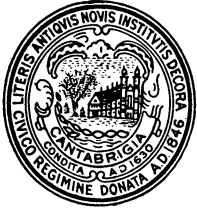

The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against James Judd in which there was a judgment of \$73.43.

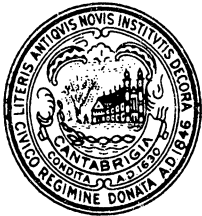
