Subject City Council Order #2 dated 5/20/91, Re: Resident Parking on Franklin St., Green St., and Pearl Street

I have re-surveyed the area of Green St., Franklin St., Pearl St. and Brookline St. with a view towards installing resident parking on these streets. After talking with our zoning specialists, we have determined that we can install resident parking on the east side of Pearl St. from Green St. to Franklin St. and on the south side of Green St. from Pearl St. to Brookline Street. I will promulgate the necessary regulations as required by law to install the signs. This will take approximately 30 days as it must be published for three consecutive weeks in a local newspaper.

As for the areas of the Forest Cities Development, I will meet with the Community Development Department, the Law Department and the Forest Cities People to determine what we can or cannot do in that area.

To implement the Resident Parking Program in areas that are now zoned Business, we must change the zoning from Business to Residental.

I, also have never removed any Resident Parking from any street in this area. There are some intersections that parking was removed for safety reasons to allow our fire apparatus and public works vehicles to enter these streets.
