COUNCILLOR VELLUCCI

- WHEREAS: The programs of the Community Learning Center provide vital educational services to 1,200 Cambridge residents each year; and
- WHEREAS: The Community Learning Center provides its services only to those adult students who have less than a high school diploma, including 600 persons of limited English-speaking ability, 200 persons enrolled in programs of literacy education, and 400 persons seeking the high school diploma or its equivalent; and
- WHEREAS: The programs of the Community Learning Center are reimbursed through state aid, and, further, receive total external funding of approximately a quarter of a million dollars per year which would otherwise be lost or drastically reduced; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That upon receipt of the anticipated additional local aid from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, the Community Learning Center be funded at a level of \$148,000 in order to enable the Center to maintain its current level of services.
